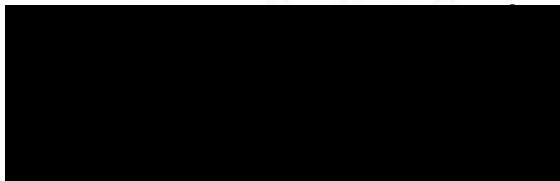

## **HOLEN BIOGRAPHY**

Lee Holen has been practicing law in Anchorage since 1978; she currently is a trial attorney with her own small firm emphasizing employment law. She represents employees, unions, and small employers in various matters, including wrongful discharge, discrimination, ADA, labor disputes, and wage and hour claims. She recently has expanded her practice to include arbitration and mediation engagements after courses at Denver University and Pepperdine University. Holen has litigated cases in Alaska State and Federal Courts, as well as before administrative agencies, with appellate work before the Alaska Supreme Court, the Ninth Circuit Federal Court of Appeals, and the U.S. Supreme Court. She has served as co-counsel with the EEOC in discrimination cases in Federal District Court here in Anchorage.

Holen received her B.A. degree from the University of Minnesota in Minneapolis, and her law degree from William Mitchell College of Law in St. Paul, Minnesota. She was co-chair of the Alaska Bar Association Employment Law Section for approximately 5 years and continues as a member; she is a member of the American Association for Justice and the Alaska Chapter, along with the National Employment Lawyers Association.

Holen has a Martindale-Hubbell rating of AV Preeminent; she was included in The Best Lawyers in America, 1996 to present; and in Who's Who in American Law, 1997 to present; Law & Politics named her an Alaska Super Lawyer in the field of Employment and Labor, 2007 to present. She speaks regularly at conferences, EEOC training seminars, continuing legal education seminars for attorneys, and to community groups regarding employment law. She also conducts sexual harassment training and workplace investigations.
