The students are not only students but customers of my institution and should be treated appropriately, without students there is no need for instructors.

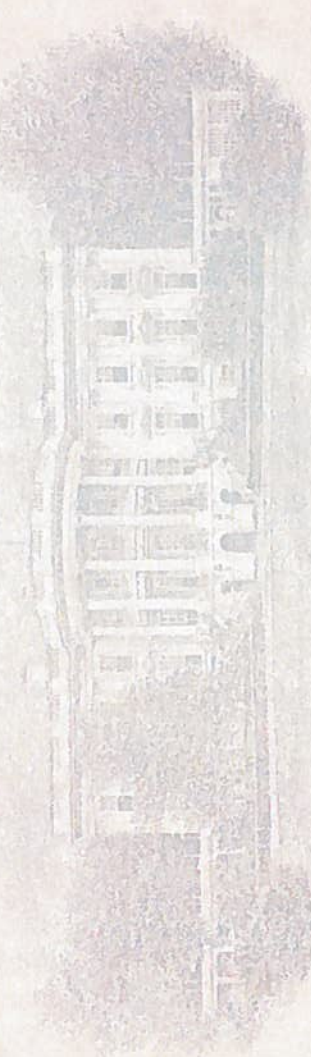
