Analysis

Section 6: amends AS 14.09.030(b)(2) to require the department to provide for school bus inspections at least once per calendar year.

The budget for school bus inspections would not change as the department would still need to have school buses inspected at least once, but could still require twice per calendar year as currently occurs. With only one school bus inspection per calendar year, a bus could go without an inspection for nearly two years. With school bus inspections conducted twice per calendar year, the longest a bus can go without an inspection is just under a year.

This section has an effective date of June 30, 2017.
