### FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

## STATE OF ALASKA 2017 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

<b>BILL NO.</b> HB 178
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Without a clearly defined nomination process, an accurate prediction of new work volume is difficult to calculate; as such, the Department is submitting a statement of indeterminate fiscal impact for HB 178.
At a minimum, the Department estimates the value of time for spending one hour per week on list maintenance would be \$2,494.70 (which will increase annually with merit increases). This number assumes no vetting of the nominations to confirm service. Such vetting would double the time expenditure per week, resulting in an expense of \$4,989.40 annually (again, increasing with merit increases). Finally, the Department would also have to add the cost for processing transactions associated with the Department accepting gifts, donations, and grants, and the Department cannot predict the number or size of these transactions.

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
