House Bill 25 Sectional Analysis —Version O

Section 1.

Sec. 21.42.427. Coverage for contraceptives.

Requires a health care insurer to provide coverage for prescription contraceptives and to provide reimbursement to a health care provider or dispensing entity for dispensing prescription contraceptives intended to last for a 12-month period for subsequent dispensing.

Section 2.

Sec. 39.30.090. Procurement of group insurance.

Clarifies that group health insurance policies covering employees of a participating governmental unit are subject to the requirements of Section 1.

Section 3.

Sec. 39.30.091. Authorization for self-insurance and excess loss insurance.

Clarifies that a self-insured group medical plan covering active state employees provided under this section is subject to the requirements of Section 1.

Section 4.

Sec. 47.07.065. Payment for prescribed drugs.

Requires the Department of Health and Social Services to pay for prescription contraceptives intended to last for a 12-month period for subsequent dispensing for eligible recipients of medical assistance, if prescribed to and requested by the recipient, as well as pay for specified related services.

Section 5.

Uncodified law - applicability

Requires the Department of Health and Social Services to amend and submit for federal approval a state plan for medical assistance coverage consistent with Section 4 of this Act.

Section 6.

Uncodified law - applicability

Provides that Section 4 of this Act takes effect only if the provisions of Section 4 of this Act receive federal approval.

Section 7.

Uncodified law – effective date

Provides for an effective date for Section 4 of this Act.

Section 8.

Uncodified law -effective date

Except for Sec. 7 of this Act, provides for a January 1, 2018 effective date.
