or	3100 clarifies the current definition of "nonconsensual common law lien" to include liens provided for by municipal rdinance(s). The current definition only expressly includes "state or federal statute" and contains no reference to unicipal ordinances.
lie	3100 also amends AS 29.35.010 by adding sub-section (17), which provides local governments the specific power to file ens on real or personal property for debts other than taxes as noted in sub-section (6) of the statute. Sub-section (17) so provides for the prioritization of liens that are filed or created under this revision to the statute.
