We would like to express our opposition to HB105, An Act Prohibiting Hunting And Trapping Of Wolves In An Area Adjacent To Denali National Park.

Management of hunting and trapping in Alaska has been delegated by the Legislature to the Board of Game. To usurp their authority with legislative action would establish a horrible precedence and a return to pre-statehood policies.
