- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- *** Section 1.** AS 16.43.060 is amended to read:
- Sec. 16.43.060. Compensation. Members of the commission are in the exempt
- service and are entitled to a monthly salary equal to a step in Range **24** [27] of the
- 7 salary schedule in AS 39.27.011.
- 8 * **Sec. 2.** AS 16.43.080(a) is amended to read:
- 9 (a) The commission may employ those persons necessary to carry out the
- purposes of this chapter. [EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMISSION ARE IN THE
- 11 EXEMPT SERVICE UNDER AS 39.25.110.]
- * **Sec. 3.** AS 39.25.110(11)(D) is repealed.
- * Sec. 4. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
- 14 read:

1	TRANSITION: ASSIGNMENT OF EXISTING STAFF MEMBERS OF THE
2	ALASKA COMMERCIAL FISHERIES ENTRY COMMISSION. Employees employed as
3	staff members of the Alaska Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission as of the effective date
4	of this Act are assigned to the classified service in accordance with AS 16.43.080, as amended
5	by sec. 2 of this Act. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, staff members of the Alaska
6	Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission employed as of the effective date of this Act
7	(1) shall immediately be appointed to the classified service;
8	(2) may not have a reduction in pay
9	(A) solely because of the assignment described in this section; or
10	(B) if the employee is assigned to a position in the classified service
11	that is classified at a lower rate of pay than that received when the position was
12	assigned to the exempt service.
