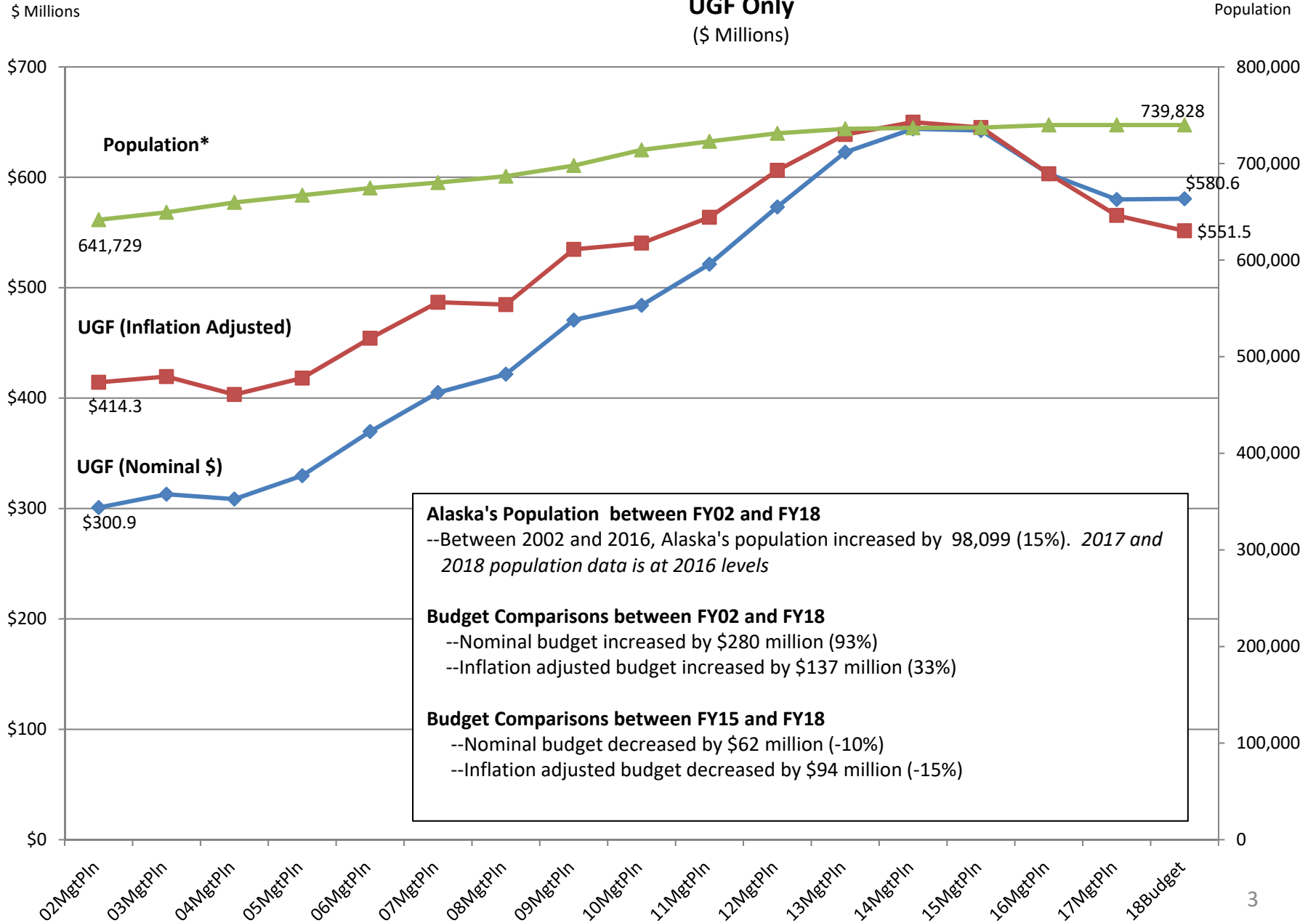

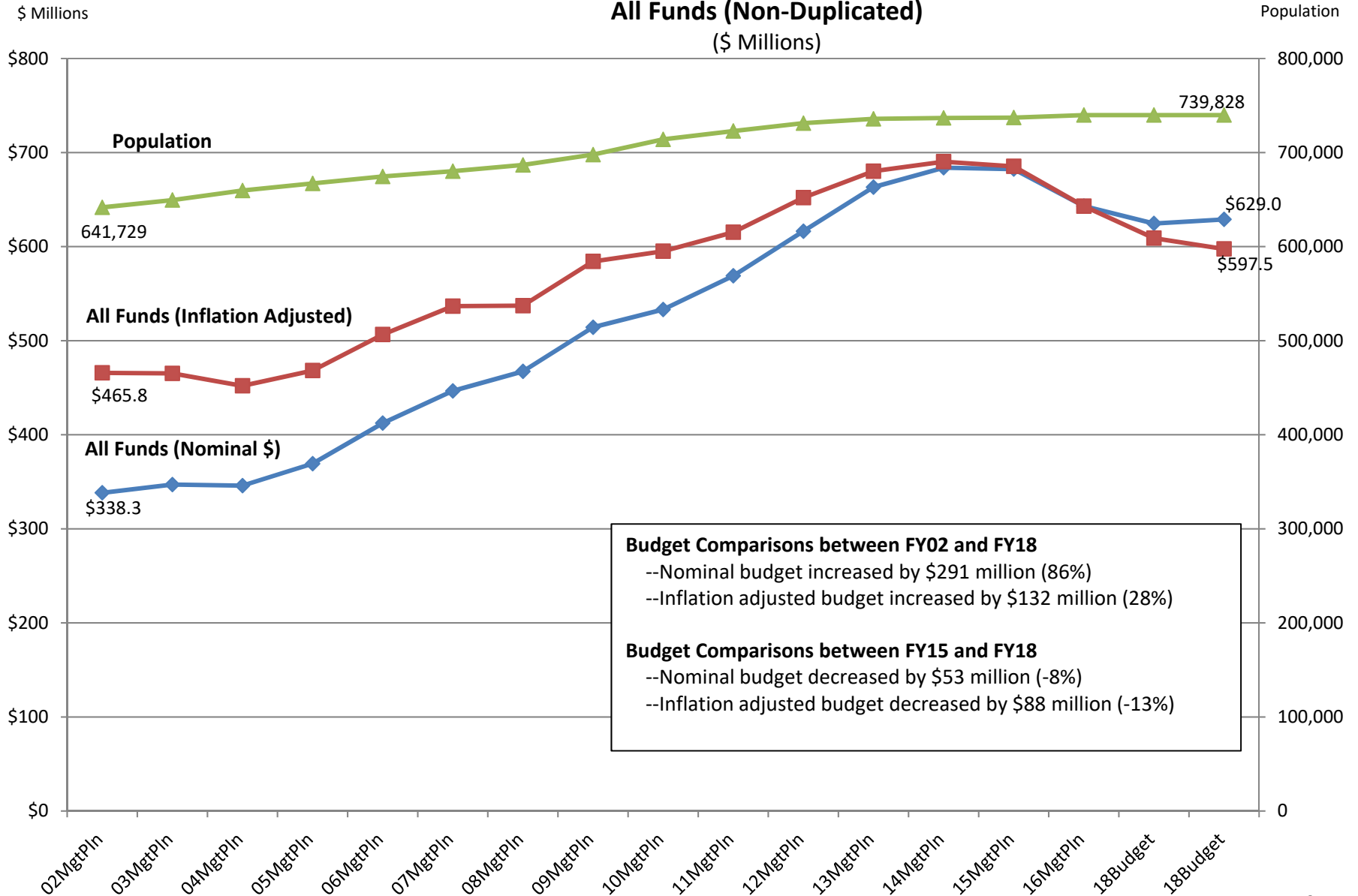

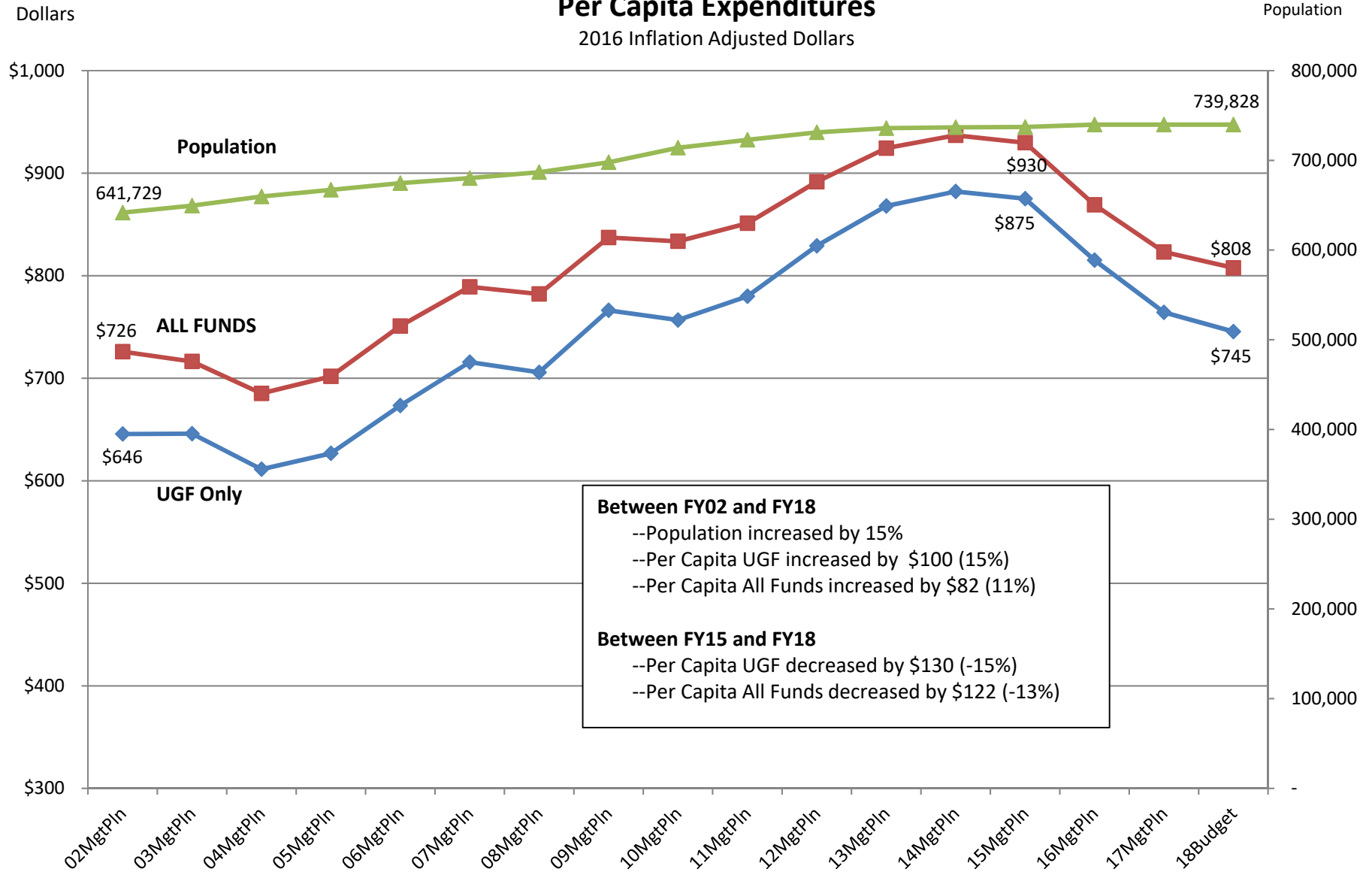

2016 Inflation Adjusted Dollars

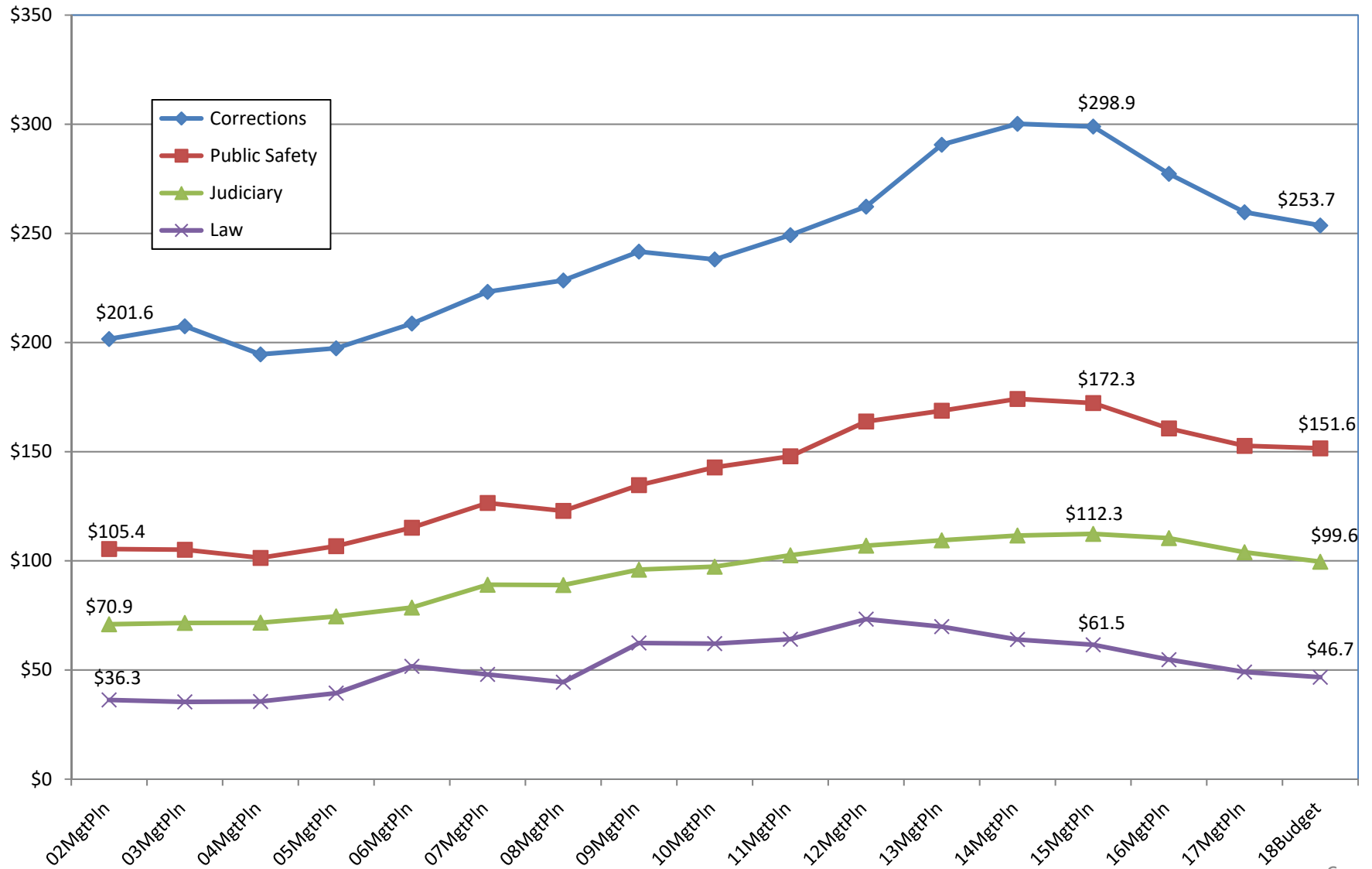

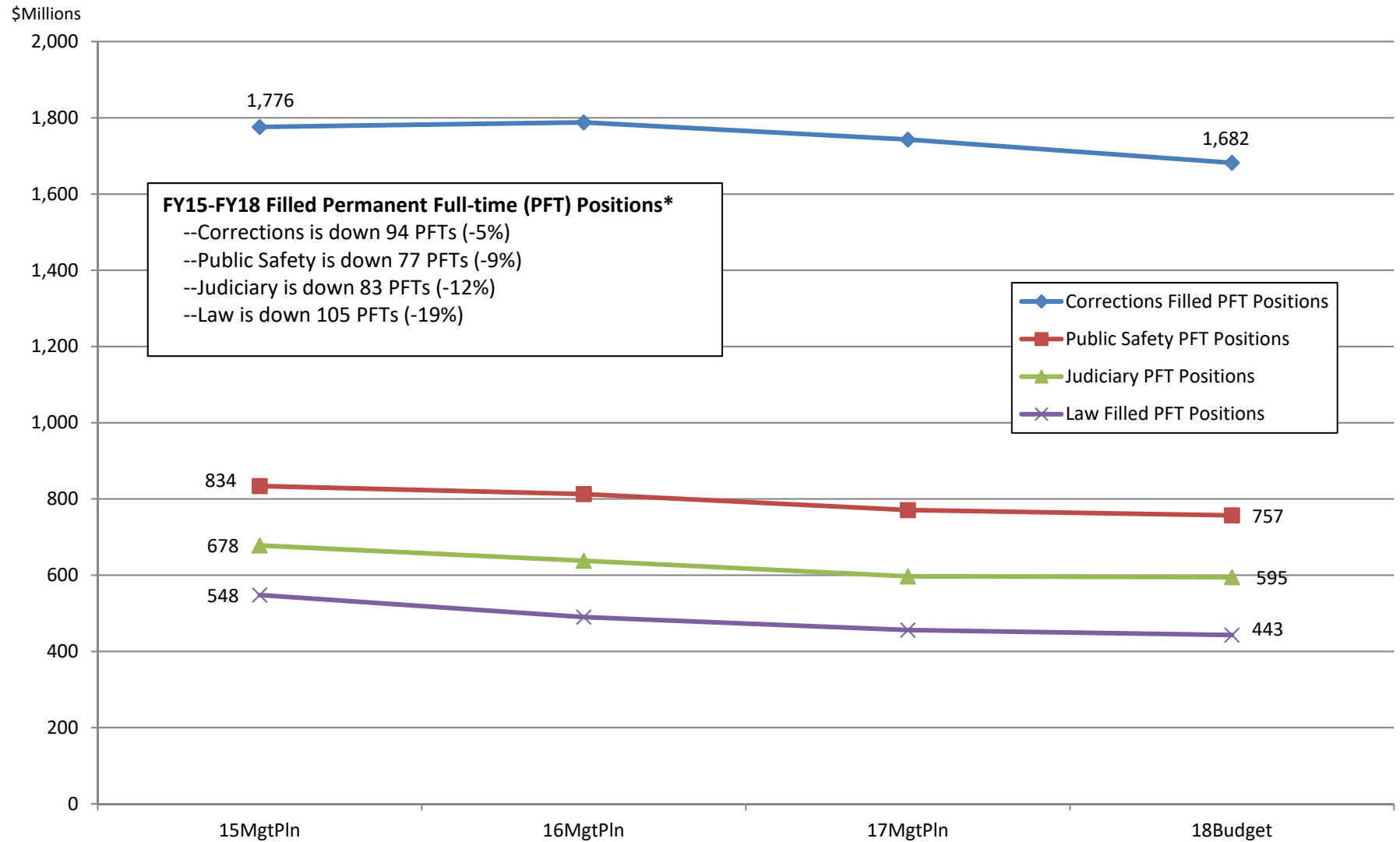

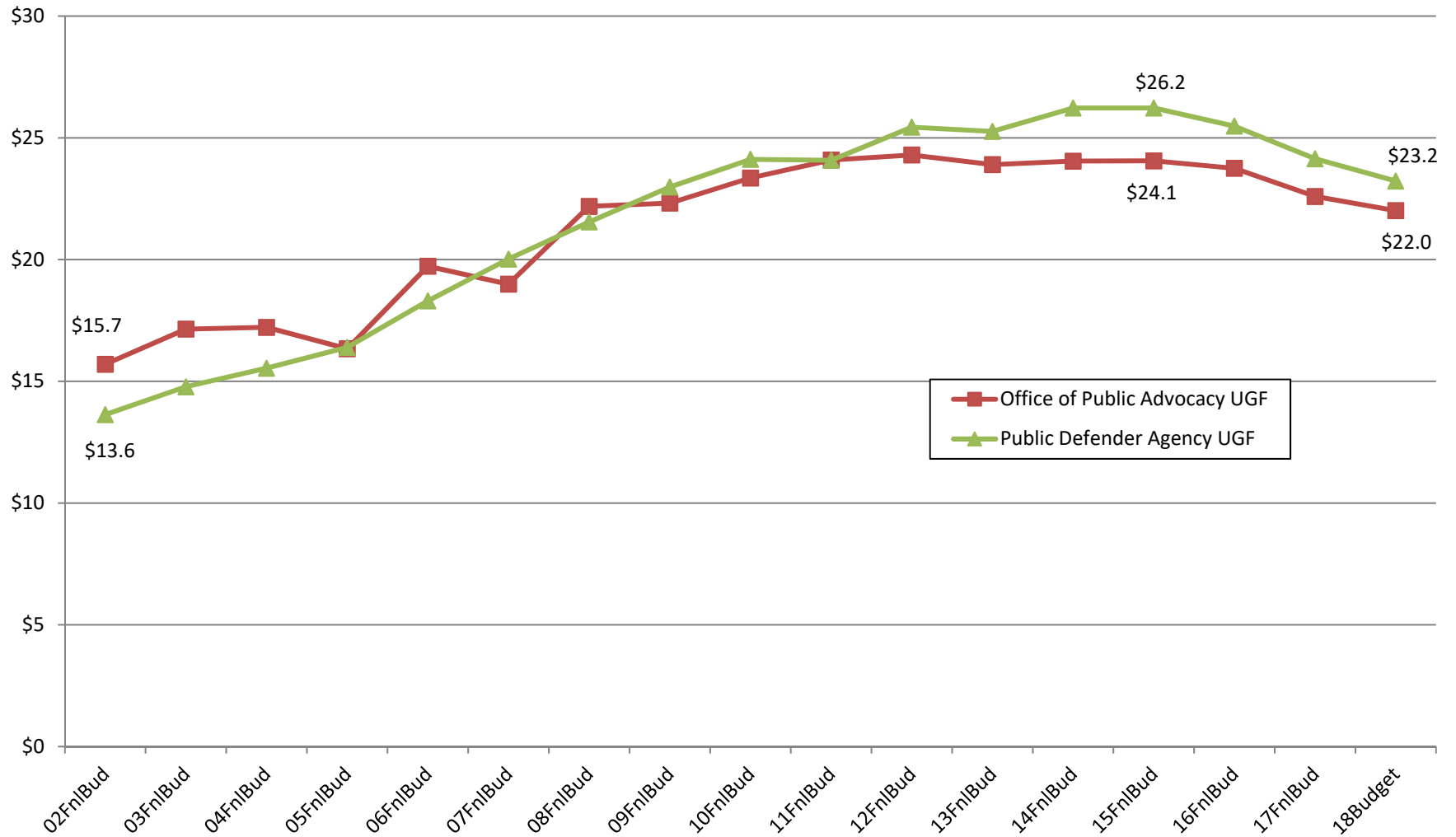

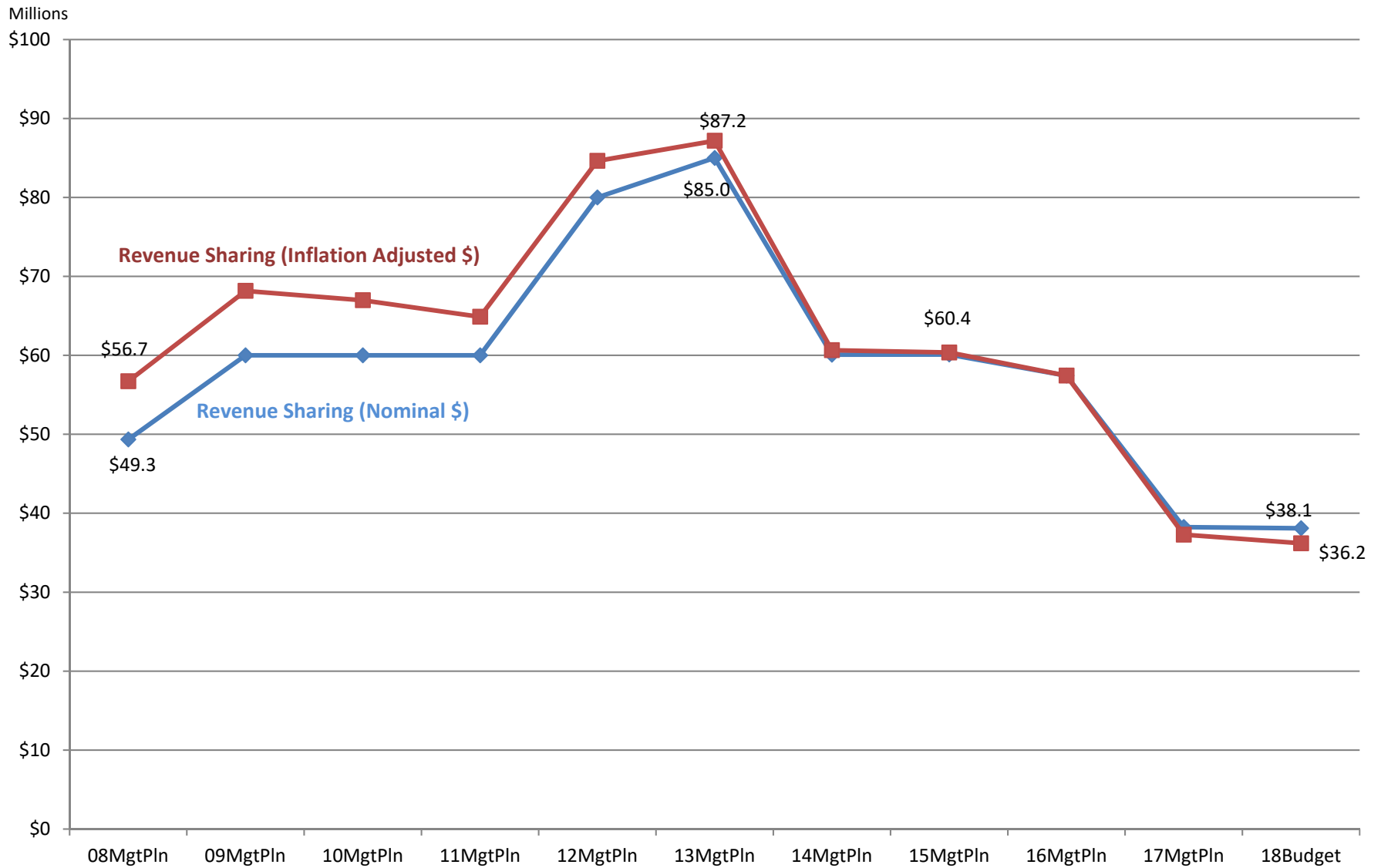
