




#### Department of Public Safety's Share of Total Agency Operations (GF Only) (\$ Thousands)




# Department of Public Safety Line Item Comparison (All Funds)








The Department of Public Safety's budget grew by \$29.5 million (All Funds) between FY08 and FY18 Governor's Request -- a 30.4% increase.


