HB301 allows the continuous holder of a beverage dispensary - tourism license (BDL-tourism) or restaurant or eating place license (REPL) that was issued under AS 04.11.400(g) before June 5, 1985, to renew and transfer ownership of the license as long as they have maintained a dining facility or kitchens in the majority of their rental rooms, maintain 10 rental rooms, and comply with other requirements of Title 04.
