Summary of Changes

HB 319 - Renew Marijuana License: Background Checks

The original version of this bill changed the fingerprinting requirement for the registration renewal of a marijuana establishment from an annual basis to once every three years.

In the House State Affairs Committee, *this requirement was amended to once every six years*. This was done to reflect a similar proposed change to Massage Therapy requirements, from requiring fingerprints every two years to once every six.

The three-year requirement as proposed in the original bill came from draft language received from the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development. This number was based on a suggestion made by Marijuana Control Board members.

The amendment was adopted with overwhelming support from members of the previous committee, and welcomed by myself, the bill's sponsor.
