

The department's total FY18 Governor's request GF budget equals \$50 per resident worker.\*

#### The Alaska Aerospace Corporation received the following general fund appropriations for on-going

funding) In FY16, all UGF was eliminated from the Alaska Aerospace Corporation's


In FY15 \$4.8 million UGF was also transferred from the Department of Education and Early Development to

directly fund the Alaska Military Youth Academy (AMYA) within the Department of Military & Veterans'

The amount of total GF in each year will reflect a lower amount compared to previous year's graphs. This is due to the National Guard and Naval Militia Retirement System transferring from DMVA's operating budget to State Retirement Payments in FY17.








### Appropriations (GF Only)



#### Appropriations within the Department of Military & Veterans' Affairs (GF Only) (\$ Thousands)








# Total Funding Comparison by Fund Group (All Funds)


