In principle I support your bill to safegard the personal data of Alaskans-but I feel it needs a provision of corcing cellular carriers to offer users a complete opt-out of all geolocation data services. The physical way in which cell phones are designed allows carriers practically unlimited access to devices (learn more about this here), so giving consumers both full transparancy and the capacity to opt-out of location data collection is essential. This is especially true in many areas of Alaska where one cellular carrier (GCI or AT&T) owns a complete monopoly over the cellular infrastructure and/or services.
