FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2017 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB 21

Analysis

Passage of this legislation will change the way permanent fund dividends are calculated and will impact the amount of PFD Criminal Funds allocated to the Department of Corrections Physical Health Care component. The reduction in the CY2016 dividend amount from the estimated \$2,072.00 to \$1,022.00 significantly reduced the amount of PFD Criminal Funds available to the department. The Department of Corrections Physical Health Care component receives a portion of the PFD Criminal Funds available which is based on a fluctuating annual PFD amount and the number of persons deemed ineligible during the appropriate year under AS 43.23.005(d). For FY2018 the amount of PFD Criminal Funds available was \$12,613,524.00 based on the CY2016 annual PFD amount of \$1,022.00 and an estimated 12,342 individuals deemed ineligible. The portion of PFD Criminal Funds available to Corrections for FY2018 is \$11,191,024.00 after the \$1,422,500.00 proposed deposit into the Crime Victim Compensation Fund. As a result, a fund source change of \$9,103,600.00 from the PFD Criminal Fund to the Alaska Capital Income Fund is requested in the FY2018 budget in order to maintain the necessary level of funding for inmate health care. Future fund source changes may be necessary based on the fluctuating annual PFD amounts and the number of persons deemed ineligible; although, actual amounts cannot be projected at this time.
