




Synchronous Distance Learning In Alaska

Solution

Explore setting up synchronous distance education courses that will be available for all Alaskan students.





Two types of distance learning...

Asynchronous- Of two or more objects or events not existing or happening at the same time.

Synchronous-Existing or occurring at the same time.

- Video: Web conferencing
- Teacher is in a different physical location
- Programs: Blackboard Collaborate, Elluminate, Zoom, and Adobe Connect.
