RE: Recreational Site License
Renewals

In 2014, the Legislative Auditor prepared a report for the ABC board's sunset review in the 2015 Legislative session. Included in the report was a finding by the auditor that some recreational site licenses were issued as "activities based" rather than "event based". The auditor found that AS 04.11.210 only permits recreational site licenses for event-based activities.

In order to address the audit findings, staff has brought all recreational site license renewal applications that were completed by November 18, 2016 to the board at this meeting.

Staff will bring all recreational site license renewal applications completed between November 18, 2016 and January 13, 2017 to the board at its February 1, 2017 board meeting.

Staff will bring all recreational site license renewal applications completed between January 13, 2017 and February 28, 2017 to the board at its April 5, 2017 meeting.

The board should review the recreational site licenses up for renewal for compliance with AS 04.11.210 in keeping with its assurance to the legislative auditor that the board has adopted a strict statutory approach to the issuance, transfer and renewal of recreational site licenses.

Staff will bring the recreational site licenses expiring in 2017 to the board next year as renewal applications for those licenses are completed.

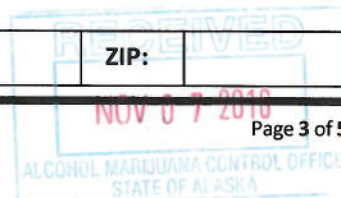

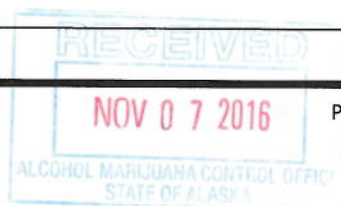

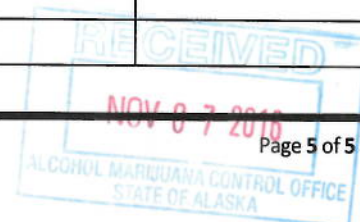

Recreational Site License Statement

The Alaska State Fair has held a Recreational Site License since 1981. To the best of my knowledge, we have had no violations in the last 25 years. We host and serve alcohol at many sporting events that have defined seasons. The Scottish Highland Games are always the last weekend in June. We serve beer and wine for the games from noon until 11:00pm. The Alaska State Horse Show Association (Hunter/Jumper group) and Rodeo Alaska's season is from May through September. During their rodeo events held here, we serve beer and wine from one hour prior to start through the time it ends. Usually this means from 12 noon – 5 pm. We serve beer and wine during the annual August/September fair from noon to midnight each day.

We have offered beer and wine at the following events as well.

Alaska Dogs Gone Wild during the third week of June.

AMTGARD retreat on the last weekend of July.

Cook Inlet Dog Shows from August through November.

Our Mission Statement includes, *"Alaska State Fair Inc. provides a center for the Alaskan community to gather in a dynamic and safe atmosphere throughout the year."*

We strive to fulfill that mission, but many events will not consider renting a facility unless we are able to provide beer and wine to their attendees.

Although many of the sporting events occur only in the summer, we hope to expand our facility rentals to host more indoor events in the winter season as well. Our facilities have been considered for roller derby and mixed martial arts events. Both have defined seasons. If we are unable to offer beer and wine service, our facilities will not even be in the running to host these events.

We are a non-profit 501C3. We depend on additional income from our interim rentals. We sincerely hope you will grant the renewal of our Recreational Site License.
