This legislation creates a new class A felony, punishable by up to twenty years of incarceration for causing another to become unconscious using hands or another object to impede breathing. The bill creates several new class C felonies, punishable by up to five years of incarceration related to masturbation. The bill also makes those charged and convicte of a sex offense ineligible to receive credit against a term of imprisonment for time spent on electronic monitoring or in treatment.	ed
The Agency cannot predict the number of new cases that may be charged as a result of this legislation or whether thos charged would be appointed a public defender. The Public Defender Agency, therefore, submits an indeterminate fisca note subject to review of estimates from the Department of Law on potential caseload increases.
