




Mission Statement



FY20 Governor's Amended Request

- > \$ 393.8 Facility Expenses
- \$3,098.0 Full-Day Fridays
 \$3,491.8 Total FY20 Increments





Policy Change – Full Day Fridays

- Court system will resume a 37.5 hour workweek and remain open for full days on Fridays
- More time for calendaring proceedings and less delay in handling court proceedings
- Alaskans will have access to courts on Friday afternoons to conduct business





Examples of Cost-Savings Measures

- ➤ Between FY16 and FY19, Deleted 44 PFT, 14 PPT, and 2 Temporary Positions for a total of 60 Deleted Positions
- Salary Schedules Capped at "R" Step
- Holding Positions Vacant to Generate Savings
- Friday Afternoon Closures
- E-Distribution Project
- Expanded Use of Videoconferencing



Alaskans Served in 2018

- 123,247 new cases filed (trial and appellate)
- 7,022 contacts through the Family Law Self Help Center
- 22,629 jurors reported for service
- 8,964 law library patrons
- 672,882 citizens passed through security screening
- 5,230,089 visits to the court's website
- 1,441,445 CourtView searches
- 19,256 online payments made
- 439 therapeutic court participants
- Thousands of on-line court forms accessed or downloaded
