## FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

### Analysis

This bill increases the minimum sentence for a first time felon with a conviction of vehicle theft from zero days to 120 days. In FY2018 there were 52 first time felons convicted of vehicle theft who received a sentence of less than 120 days. The additional incarceration days required to bring each of those offenders to a minimum sentence of 120 days is 5,132. After the one-third reduction for statutory good time, that is an additional 3,387 projected incarceration days due to this change. At a cost of \$168.74 per day, the cost of those additional days is \$571,522.
