Juneau Parents as Teachers: Outcomes

The AEYC Juneau Parents as Teachers is a voluntary home visiting program for any family that is pregnant or with a child up to age 3. Juneau Parents as Teachers is designed to support young families, increase parent knowledge of early childhood development, and improve parenting practices. Parents who participate for a least a year are provided an exit survey when they complete the program. Here is what they had to say.


I feel supported as a parent
