- AS 29.60.600 authorizes the department to make grants to qualified municipalities Fairbanks North Star Borough, Municipality of Anchorage, Mat-Su Borough
- Services substance abuse treatment, mental health services, food and shelter for the low income, sexual assault shelters, domestic violence treatment, runaway shelters, health services for low-income, housing and rehabilitation for the physically and mentally ill
- Services are purchased through contracts with non-profit sub-grantee agencies.

- Services homeless shelters; soup kitchens and food banks; non-residential emergency shelters; outreach to homeless/homeless find; distribution centers for essential items such as sleeping bags and cold weather gear; and transportation vouchers/services supporting access to basic essential services and medical providers
