FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. SB 51

Analysis

This legislation directs the Department of Environmental Conservation to accept nominations for waters to be designated as Outstanding National Resource Waters. The Department, along with the Departments of Fish and Game and Natural Resources may agree to further forward a nomination on to the legislature to recommend designation.

The anticipated work load to review and potentially forward nominations can be done with the existing staff within the Department. No additional staff will be required.

Regulations may be promulgated to describe the process for nomination.
