SUBCOMMITTEE MEETINGS

The House Finance Budget Subcommittee for the Department of Environmental Conservation held five meetings with the department during the review of the FY20 budget request.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The House Finance Budget Subcommittee for the Department of Environmental Conservation recommends that the House Finance Committee accept the Department of Environmental Conservation's FY20 budget with the following amendment recommendations:

The Unrestricted General Fund difference from FY15 Management Plan to the FY20 House Subcommittee recommended budget is a reduction of \$6,882.1, a decrease of 30.9 percent.

The Unrestricted General Fund difference from FY20 Adjusted Base to the FY20 House Subcommittee Recommended budget is a decrease of \$31.9, a decrease of 0.2 percent.

GOVERNOR'S AMENDED BUDGET PROPOSALS

The Governor submitted 17 budget action items. The House Finance Subcommittee accepted 6 of them. The House Finance Subcommittee rejected 11 of them. The items the House Finance Subcommittee rejected are:

5 items reducing travel line funding across all fund sources by 50%

- 4 items eliminating the Ocean Ranger program and related fund source changes
- 1 item eliminating the dairy program
- 1 item eliminating an Economist III position

SUBCOMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

The following House Finance Subcommittee budget amendments are submitted to the House Finance Committee for consideration:

- 1) An amendment removing the following wordage: At the discretion of the Office of Management and Budget, funding may be transferred between all appropriations in the Department.
- 2) A 50% cut to Unrestricted General Funds in the travel line of four allocations, listed below, for a total decrement of \$41.2 from the FY20AdjBase.
 - a. Office of the Commissioner (\$7.6)
 - b. Administrative Services (\$0.3)
 - c. Air Quality (\$4.4)
 - d. Water Quality, Infrastructure Support & Financing (\$28.9)
- 3) Intent language stating that it is the intent of the legislature that, with regards to the Air Quality situation in the Fairbanks North Star Borough, the Department of Environmental Conservation shall:
 - 1. Submit a Serious State Implementation Plan (SIP) as quickly as possible that includes sufficiently stringent Best Available Control Technologies (BACT) and Best Available Control Measures (BACM) to be legally defensible and approvable by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
 - 2. Maintain adequate DEC staff in the Fairbanks North Star Borough and streamline the Notice of Violation (NOV) process to ensure compliance with current regulations in place and additional regulations implemented under the Serious SIP.
 - 3. DEC shall coordinate with local governments impacted by PM 2.5 non-attainment to best utilize municipal powers for mitigation, monitoring and enforcement to the maximum extend possible under state and local law.
