Analysis

The Department currently receives Medicaid Disproportional Share Hospital funding in support of the Alaska Psychiatric Institute (\$15,000.0, 50% UGF/50% Federal) and traditional medicaid revenues (\$6,005.4 million, 30% UGF/70% Federal). Together, these funding sources total \$21,005.4 with the general fund portion making up \$9,301.7. The likely outcome of this legislation would lead API to be unable to serve the mentally ill population of the state and it is assumed that these individuals would ultimately have to be housed in inpatient units throughout the state. The average inpatient rate for the major hospitals throughout the state is \$3.1 per day. At this rate for 80 patients over the course of a year (365 days), the state Medicaid program would likely have to pick up the cost of care for these individuals. The Department assumes that 80% of these individuals would be Medicaid Eligible with private insurance and Medicare picking up the additional 20%. The total additional cost for caring for these patients in hospitals throughout the state equates to \$56,609.3 from the state Medicaid Program for a total cost of \$77,614.7 (\$3.1 average inpatient hospital rate * 80 beds * 365 days/year * 80% assumed Medicaid Eligible proportion).

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
