House Bill 118

“An Act relating to the duties of the commissioner of corrections; and relating to planning for prisoner reentry.”

Sectional Analysis Version S

Section 1

AS 33.30.011(a) – Duties of commissioner.

Pages 2-3, lines 28-1
Conforming change.

Page 3, lines 5-6
Amends subsection (8) to exclude prisoners sentenced to a term of 99 years from the department’s requirement to produce a written case plan within the time required.

This excludes from the reentry plan program those who are incarcerated for life.

Page 3, lines 7-8
Amends subsection (A) by changing the effective date to require that a written case plan take effect within 90 days after a prisoner’s sentencing.

Page 4, lines 3-5
Creates a new subsection (D) confirming that the Department of Corrections should coordinate with community reentry coalitions or other providers of reentry services when developing a written case plan for prisoners.

Page 4, lines 14-25
Creates a new subsection (12) requiring regular reports on offender management plan implementation that includes the number of prisoners provided written case plans and the percentage of the target population that number represents; the number of written case plans initiated within the preceding year, and the number of written case plans that were updated in the preceding year.
