FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2019 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This legislation amends the crimes of theft in the second degree to include the theft of an identification document. Under the legislation, theft in the second degree would also include theft of property or services occurring within 180 days in which the combined value was \$750.00 or more but less than \$25,000.00. Theft in the second degree is a class C felony. The legislation also amends fraudulent use of an access devise to include the fraudulent use of an identification document. Fraudulent use of an access device is a class B felony if the value of the property or services obtained is \$25,000.00 or more, a C felony if the value is more than \$750.00 but less than \$25,000.00, and a class A misdemeanor if the value is less than \$750.00. The legislation also enacts a new criminal offense; possession of motor vehicle theft tools. A person commits the crime of possession of motor vehicle theft tools if the person possesses motor vehicle theft tools with the intent to commit a vehicle theft. Vehicle theft tools includes: altered or shaved keys and trial or jiggler keys. Possession of motor vehicle theft tools is a class A misdemeanor. The Department of Law does not anticipate a fiscal impact from this legislation.
