- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- 3 * Section 1. AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:
- Sec. 44.12.157. Alaska Native Heritage Month. The month of November each year is established as Alaska Native Heritage Month. Alaska Native Heritage Month may be observed by schools, community groups, and other public and private agencies and individuals with appropriate activities to honor and recognize the contributions made by Alaska Natives in the history of this state and the United States.
