## **Analysis**

The portion of this proposal which impacts the department is the repeal of AS 35.27. This proposal removes the requirement to use one percent of the construction cost of a building or facility (which the department is responsible for designing and constructing) for the design, construction, mounting, and administration of works of art. This proposal does not create more funding for the department's capital projects, but will result in additional funding available for the actual construction costs of the public building and facilities projects.

Examples of funding diverted from prior construction costs to the art in public places fund on departmental public building and facilities projects are as follow:
