## FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA  
2018 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. HB 76

### Analysis

This legislation establishes the 2018 International Residential Code as the new "State Residential Code" for residential construction statewide, eliminating the applicability of the statewide plumbing code adopted under AS 18.60.705.

The adoption of the 2018 International Residential Code would eliminate certificate of fitness requirements for plumbing work on residential construction. AS 18.60.705 and certificate of fitness requirements would still apply to commercial plumbing installations and most plumbers perform a mixture of residential and commercial work. Consequently, the division does not expect a recognizable change in certificate of fitness fee revenue.
