SUBJECT: CSHB 68 Sunset Provisions
(Work Order No. 31-GH1049; CSHB 68(L&C))

You have asked for an explanation of how the sunset provisions in Work Order No. 31-GH1049\M work.

Under sec. 33 of this draft, the amendments to existing law made by sections 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17, 19, 21, 23, 25, 27, and 29, have a July 1, 2019, effective date. Under sec. 32 of the draft, effective July 1, 2022, those amendments will be reversed by secs. 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 22, 24, 26, 28, and 30.

The July 1, 2019, and July 1, 2022 effective dates are special effective dates and must receive two-thirds vote by both bodies. If the special effective date sections fail, the bill would become effective on the date the governor signs the bill or 90 days after the passage of the bill by both bodies, whichever is earlier. In that case, the amendments will take effect and will immediately be reversed, with the net effect being no change to the statutes.
