This bill will require an additional checkbox to be placed on the Permanent Fund Dividend application indicating whether an individual would like to be registered to vote through the Automatic Voter Registration process. This will not take significant resources, therefore it is a zero fiscal note. The division will report these individuals to Elections annually.
