FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. HB 129

Analysis

The Department of Fish and Game currently offers a free license to active members of the military and disabled veterans who have incurred a 50 percent or greater disability during military service. This legislation will expand that free license, along with waterfowl tags, to all residents with at least a 50 percent disability or receiving at least 50 percent disability compensation from a government agency for a physical disability.

The department lacks the data to accurately determine the increase in free licenses and tags that would be distributed under this legislation. Therefore, this fiscal note reflects an indeterminate decrease in the Fish & Game Fund.
