Analysis

This legislation increases the minimum wage from \$9.89 per hour to \$15.00 per hour as of January 1, 2020, and establishes requirements for the department to collaborate with the Alaska Commission for Human Rights to produce a report of pay practices in Alaska by election district, make the report available to the public, and file the report with the Alaska Commission for Human Rights and both bodies of the Legislature.			
Although the proposed wage increase is significant, past increases in the Alaska minimum wage have not resulted in a recognizable increase in wage claims or enforcement actions. Consequently, the department does not anticipate a fiscal impact associated with investigations or enforcement actions associated with the increased minimum wage.
