FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2019 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. HB 28

Analysis

This legislation increases the minimum wage in Alaska from \$9.89 per hour to \$15.00 per hour effective January 1, 2020. It requires the Department of Labor and Workforce Development to produce an annual report on fair pay practices, and directs the Alaska State Commission for Human Rights (Commission) to consult and collaborate in the preparation of the report upon request. The report is to be filed with the Commission and the Legislature.

This fiscal note presumes that costs associated with the reporting requirements in this legislation would be incurred by the Department of Labor and Workforce Development. Therefore, a zero fiscal note is submitted.
