Intensive Outpatient Services - Adults

- 131 Clients Served
- 43 % Completed
 Treatment vs. 25 %
 Statewide Avg. (16%
 Referred)



Outpatient Services - Adults

- 104 Clients Served
- 59 % Completed
 Treatment vs. 39 %
 Statewide Avg. (4%
 Referred)



Peer Support



46 Clients Served

Women's Residential

- 36 Clients Served
- 59 % Completed Treatment vs 39 % Statewide Avg. (6% Referred)
- TOTAL Reunifications 14
- Children born to a Sober Mom
 While Attending VORTC 2



Children's Behavioral Health

- Treating Children with
 Trauma –Early Intervention
- 65 Children Served
- 42 % Completed Treatment vs. 27 % Statewide Avg. (9% Referred)



Overall Outcomes – All programs

- 82 % Evidence Decrease in Substance Use
- 69 % Improvement on Quality of Life Domains
- 94 % Treated with Respect and Satisfied with Services
- 77 % Stated Served Improved Their Overall Quality of Life
- 69 % Increase in Hours Engaged in Productive Activities During the Week (Work, Volunteering, Subsistence)

Mental Health Improvement

- Upon Discharge 1 day of 30
 Days Clients Experienced Poor
 Mental Health
- Upon Admission 11 days of 30 Days - Clients Experienced Poor Mental Health



- Overall Decrease In:

- Legal Involvement
- Partner Abuse

Overall Improvement In:

- Physical Health
- Life Satisfaction
- Employment

- 10 Pregnant Women Served
- 59 Injection Users Served

Referral Source

- 33% OCS
- 27% ASAP
