

Coast Guard Forces Stationed in Alaska







Cruise Ship Traffic for 2019



Vessels in D17 Arctic Area of Interest




2025 U.S. Arctic Vessel Activity Projections






Fuel Storage Facility Inspections






Pelagic Strike/Alaska Shield




- CG participated in State-wide Alaska Shield Full Scale Exercise

CG Priorities:

- **100% Accountability of CG members and Families**
 - Achieved
- **Safety of Life/SAR**
 - Shifted airborne C-130 to SAR mission
 - Immediate launch 6 aircraft
 - Juneau assumed Sector Anchorage SAR coordination
- **Port Assessment/Recovery**
 - Sector coordinated with port partners
 - CG LNOs deployed to SEOC and FEMA RRCC
