A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to the manufacture, sale, and distribution of products containing certain flame retardant chemicals; relating to an interstate chemicals clearinghouse; adding unlawful acts to the Alaska Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer Protection Act; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* **Section 1.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read:

SHORT TITLE. This Act may be known as the Toxic-Free Firefighters and Children Act.

FINDINGS. The legislature finds that

(1) flame retardant chemicals are not needed to provide fire safety;

(2) many flame retardant chemicals commonly contained in furniture are toxic
