#### 2019 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

#### Analysis

SB6 creates an early education program, under AS 14.03.135, that is approved by the Department of Education & Early Development and funded by the state through a three-year grant process. Once those districts have completed the three-year grant cycle and the department has determined the early education program complies with adopted standards as created by the State Board of Education & Early Development, then those programs may be eligible for 1/2 the full-time equivalent for average daily membership (ADM) funding under AS 14.17.410. Foundation funding would only be provided to those districts that are not already being funded by another state or federal program.

Page 3 of this fiscal note provides the funding breakdown by fiscal year for the three-year grant program.

Costs associated with the operation of the development grants are reflected in the Early Learning Coordination fiscal note.

No effective date has been provided.
