BILL NO. SB 76 (L&C)

Analysis

The proposed legislation will repeal the Workers' Compensation Appeals Commission as of December 31, 2020, and adjust statutes and court rules associated with transferring the authority to decide Workers' Compensation Board appeals from the commission to the Alaska Superior Court.

This legislation would eliminate two positions and associated funding necessary to operate the Workers' Compensation Appeals Commission. Based on the December 31, 2020, date for the final repeal of the commission, cost savings are expected to be 50% of the Commission's FY2021 net budget after fixed costs are removed. Fixed cost estimates are based on FY2020 rates. Fixed cost rates are generally set before the beginning of the fiscal year and include lease costs, phone billings, risk management rates, and department support costs, among others.

The regulations applicable to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Commission under 8 AAC 57.010 through 8 AAC 56.990 would need to be amended/repealed.
