STATE OF ALASKA 2020 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

The proposed legislation adds commercial vessels with a valid commercial fishing license to the list of boats that are exempt from numbering and registration. The registration fee for each power boat is \$24.00; the fee for each non-power boat is \$10.00. Registration fees are collected every three years, or upon a change of ownership.

Boats that exceed 24 feet in length are also required to be titled. Title fees are collected once upon the original issuance of the title, or upon a change of ownership or duplicate request by the owner. 2019 was the first year that commercial fishing vessels documented with the US Coast Guard were required to be titled and registered so the Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) assumes the following years will follow the same registration trend as historical years. The DMV doesn't have data that tells us how often these boats are sold but the DMV estimates it is 10% or less to estimate title transaction demand.
