# STATE OF ALASKA 2020 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. HB 182

## **Analysis**

This bill amends AS 44.41.065(a) by reducing the amount of time in which the state crime lab must test a sexual assault examination kit from one year to 60 days after the crime lab receives the sexual assault examination kit.

To achieve a 60-day turnaround time for testing of sexual assault examination kits while maintaining the current level of service for other DNA services (property crimes, homicides, etc.), the crime lab estimates that five new Forensic Scientist III positions and one new Forensic Technician position would be needed for a total annual cost of \$607,500. Necessary consumables (chemicals for testing) associated with testing performed by the staff is estimated at \$155,000 annually. The crime lab would also need to outsource kits the first two years, though it is not expected that any private forensic science service provider could meet a 60-day testing window.

Should this bill pass, the total first year costs are estimated at \$1,260,900 which includes nine months of personal services costs for five new Forensic Scientist III positions and one new Forensic Technician position, the cost of consumables for training the new staff, outsourcing of 360 sexual assault examination kits to maintain turnaround times while the new staff are trained, build out of additional office space, and purchase of two new instruments capable of handling the additional workflow.

Second year costs are estimated at \$960,500 which includes annual personal services costs for the six positions, annual costs for necessary consumables, and outsourcing of 180 sexual assault examination kits.

Third and subsequent years costs are estimated at \$762,500 which includes annual personal services costs for the six positions and annual costs for necessary consumables.

This fiscal note is contingent on approval of funding and positions requested in the Governor's FY2021 operating budget. Should that request not be approved, this fiscal note will need to be increased by an additional two Forensic Scientist positions, one Forensic Technician position, necessary consumables, and costs for appropriate outsourcing.
