A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to testing of sexual assault examination kits; and providing for an
- 2 effective date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 44.41.065(a) is amended to read:
- 5 (a) When a law enforcement agency collects a sexual assault examination kit 6 under AS 18.68.010, the agency shall
- 7 (1) within 30 days after the agency collects the sexual assault 8 examination kit, send the sexual assault examination kit to an accredited laboratory in coordination with the Department of Public Safety or a laboratory operated by the Department of Public Safety;
- 12 (2) ensure that the laboratory to which the sexual assault examination 12 kit is sent under (1) of this subsection conducts a serological or DNA test on the 13 sexual assault examination kit within <u>60 days</u> [ONE YEAR] after the laboratory 14 receives the sexual assault examination kit; and

1	(3) within two weeks after the laboratory that receives the sexual
2	assault examination kit under (1) of this subsection completes serological or DNA
3	testing, make a reasonable effort to notify the victim from whom the sexual assault
4	examination kit was collected that the sexual assault examination kit has been tested.
5	* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 2020.
