How do we teach and assess reading?

- Everyday, preschool children are involved in multiple activities and intentional teaching practices that focus on the 5 core areas of literacy instruction.
 - Full infusion of language, literacy and reading throughout the four hour preschool day. The classroom is arranged to include a library area, and literacy incorporated in all Interest areas: blocks, dramatic play, toys and games, area, discovery, sand and water, music and movement, cooking and outdoors.
 - Small Group Instruction on literacy skills
 - Individual and small group interventions
