The attached bill adds a new section amending AS 18.65.310, to require numeric characters that are in the applicant's legal name to appear on state identification cards in addition to state driver's licenses. As we have previously advised by phone, the addition of this requirement for a state identification card is unnecessary because AS 18.65.310(a) requires an identification card to be identical to a driver's license under AS 28.15.111.1

You also requested that the REAL ID federal Act be amended to require the use of numeric characters that are in the applicant's legal name. The state legislature has no authority over federal law requirements. As discussed in the memorandum to your office dated November 27, 2019, the use of numeric characters in names may not comply with the REAL ID Act. If a state law requirement to add numeric characters to state identification cards and drivers' licenses conflicts with federal identification requirements, the cards and licenses could not be used when a REAL ID card is federally required.
