Anchorage Trash & Recycling

 Annual garbage disposed at Anchorage Regional Landfill: 300,000 tons

 Commodities recycling processed by WestRock: 24,000 tons per year

• Estimated ARL closure: 2063



Why Organics?

- Makes up 25 percent of all residential solid waste
- Estimate 50,000 tons of material per year for residential collection
- 40,000 tons commercial collection
- Recommended item in both SWS Master Plan and MOA Climate Action Plan
- Requested by the community
- Stays local

WHAT WE TAKE

CURBSIDE ORGANICS

- Commingled collection of food scraps and yard trimmings
- Pink cart program
- Followed a 2017 "yard waste" pilot

CURBSIDE ORGANICS







2019 Curbside Organics

- 800 SWS participants
- 109 Alaska Waste Participants
- 271 tons collected
- Average 20 pounds per household, per week



- Started in 2016
- Two locations
- Free drop-off for food scraps
- "Leave a Bucket, Take a Bucket"
- 143 yards of compost distributed








ASD Organics

- Partnership with Central Recycling Services
- 11 schools, weekly collection
- Collecting 2,000 pounds per week
- Gives us insight on institution level collection
