The amount represents a portion of the Department's reported and planned FY20 expenditures from this allocation for outside counsel contracts. The FY20 budget stated, "It is the intent of the legislature that the Department of Law minimize the use of outside counsel." Outside counsel expenditures from the Labor and State Affairs allocation have exceeded 300.0 in FY20 YTD, with the potential for an additional 600.0 under a contract signed on January 8, 2020. Contracts for Labor and State Affairs outside counsel include attorney billing rates up to \$600/hour. The subcommittee did not find evidence of concerted effort to reduce rates, to focus scarce state resources on those cases with the highest likelihood of success or financial return, or to limit the use of outside counsel.
