Analysis

This bill establishes a state lottery through the creation of a State Lottery Board as a mechanism to generate revenue for the state. In addition to establishing the board the bill also creates new class C felonies for individuals who engage in the unauthorized sale of lottery tickets. This includes individuals not authorized to sell tickets, those who sell tickets for a price higher than the fixed price, those who sell tickets to minors, those who sell counterfeit or altered tickets, or those impersonating lottery representatives.		
The Public Defender Agency cannot anticipate the number of new cases that will be charged under this legislation nor how many of those cases would require appointed counsel. The Public Defender Agency, therefore, submits an indeterminate fiscal note.
