Analysis

The Alaska legislature established the Technical Vocational Education Program (TVEP) in 2000. The program is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2020. The University of Alaska (UA) is a comprehensive and productive provider of workforce training in Alaska that has been a major recipient of TVEP funding to expand workforce development training since the program's inception. The TVEP program at UA provides grants across the state for industry-specific, on-the-job, and classroom training, impacting thousands of students. In FY19, UA served at total of 4,492 students through the program. The TVEP program is administered by the Alaska Workforce Investment Board per AS 23.15.820 and is funded from a portion of Unemployment Insurance receipts. Program funds are distributed to statutorily designated technical and vocational education entities (AS 23.15.835) to be used for training and educating Alaskans in high-demand occupations. Program funds are allocated to recipients based on the percentages outlined in AS 23.15.835(d) with the University of Alaska receiving 45% of available program funds. Current year, FY20, planned distribution for the entire program is \$12,488.5. UA's 45% allocation is \$5,619.3. This fiscal note is based on FY20 program funds until such time as DOLWD provides revised estimates for FY21 allocations. HB235 reauthorizes the TVEP program for three years, through June 2023.
