FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2020 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. HB242

Analysis

HB 242 proposes several changes to the state's controlled substance prescription database (known as the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program or "PDMP"), which is established under the Board of Pharmacy within the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED), Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing (CBPL). The legislation mandates prescribing boards (State Medical Board, Board of Nursing, Board of Veterinary Examiners, Board of Examiners in Optometry, and Board of Dental Examiners) and the Board of Pharmacy adopt certain PDMP registration and use requirements.

HB 242 also expands the utility of the PDMP and establishes additional authority to investigate and discipline those who fail to use the database as mandated by state law. The bill also enhances the PDMP as a tool to deter opioid misuse and to act on the licenses of practitioners who overprescribe opioids. CBPL anticipates that these changes will result in additional investigations, license actions, and appeals of boards' disciplinary decisions.

Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by Receipt Supported Services (fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF)). Licensing fees for each occupation are set per AS 08.01.065. The total amount of revenue collected approximately equals the occupation's actual regulatory costs. The division receives no UGF funding.
